Carpet Cleaning Solution



Detergent solution:

- 1/4 teaspoon of a mild liquid dishwashing detergent*
- 1 cup of warm water

Neutralizing solution:

- 1 cup of white vinegar
- 2 cups of water

Instructions:

1. Blot (never rub) with a dry, white absorbent cloth or white (never patterned or colored) paper towel.
2. Apply a very small amount of the detergent solution to a white cloth and blot, working from the edges of the stain to the center to prevent spreading.
3. Continue to blot until all the stain is transferred to the cloth.
4. Apply a small amount of the neutralizing solution mix to the area to lower the alkalinity of the detergent.
5. Rinse the area with cold water and blot dry with clean white cloth.

*Note: do **not** use laundry or automatic dish washing detergent as they can contain agents that can harm carpet dyes and fibers
